Mission:

The mission of Nourish is to provide family and community support for children with feeding challenges.

Who we are:

Nourish is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to providing family and community support for children with feeding challenges through scholarships for dietician evaluations, direct feeding therapy (occupational and/or speech) or special equipment for which insurance is either not available or does not cover. Scholarships are made possible through grants and YOUR generous donations. We also offer support groups for parents, family, and professionals so they can work together to determine the best therapy plan for each child.

How it works:

Just send a donation (or make one online) and we'll send you a receipt for your records. Contributions to Nourish are eligible for an Arizona Tax Credit for Donations (\$938 limit for married couples filing jointly, \$470 limit for single filers, head of household, or married couples filing separately). The Tax Credit for Donations is separate from the Arizona School tax credits. Contributions which qualify for this credit result in a dollar for dollar reduction in your state tax liability, and go directly back into helping children in Southern Arizona.

The QCO code for Nourish is 20681.
